PMA GP Practice Manager ILM Level 5 Diploma in Leadership & Management

This qualification is suitable for practice staff who are now expected to manage and lead projects and teams. They may be taking their first steps into line management and have some management responsibilities.

These diplomas offer individuals and practices a fabulous opportunity for succession planning, to network with peer groups and gain a range of essential key, transferable leadership and management skills to support the individual's development in return for a demonstrable level of commitment to learning.
